

STEP 1 APPLY *To be a student at TTU, you must complete the non-refundable application and pay the app fee (if you do not have a Credit card, you can continue to apply and pay the app fee later)*

1. To apply you must first do the application online, you can start here:

Be sure to select if you are a Freshmen or Transfer student.

STEP 2 SUBMIT DOCUMENTS

You will need to send the following items for your admissions:

Submit originals or certified copies of all marked sheets (all years of high school), transcripts, diplomas, leaving certificates, A or O levels and/or leaving certificates from high school or other academic institutions.

Please note, you can initially EMAIL a copy of your transcripts for an initial admissions review.

Official translations must be provided when originals are not in English.

Are you a transfer student?

If you are a college or university transfer student who attended university overseas who is requesting transfer credit, first check to see if your institution is recognized in the USA by going to www.whed.net. If your institution is listed, we may require course description of each class and they must accompany the transcripts. If your institution is not listed on [whed.net](http://www.whed.net) you will need to have an official evaluation done by WES at <https://www.wes.org/required-documents> and/or Educational Perspectives at www.edperspectives.com

Students from nations where it is difficult to send more than 1 copy may send a copy to TTU for initial review.

STEP 3 SUBMIT TEST SCORES If you have any exams, please submit these for admission, we only require one of the following test for admissions

- a. We accept TOEFL IBT of 61 or higher or the Paper based TOEFL of 490 or higher
- b. We also accept TOEIC 600+ or IELTS 5.5
- c. SAT scores (the SAT test is optional) of 460 on Critical Reading or 460 on the Math section, students wanting to study Nursing, Engineering and Pre-Medicine are required to have higher scores for admission
- d. ACT scores (the ACT test is also optional) of 17 on English or Math; students wanting to study Nursing, Engineering and Pre-Medicine may be required to have higher scores for admission
- e. Students who did AP credit; IB (international baccalaureate) courses and Cambridge O or A levels should submit your results, as you may be entitled to college credits

STEP 4 ONCE YOU ARE ADMITTED, YOU CAN APPLY FOR A VISA

- 1. All students must provide their home address to be able to receive an Immigration document for your visa called the I-20.
- 2. So be sure to use your home (overseas) address if you need an I-20, we will also need a copy of your passport for the issuance of the I-20.

STEP 6 SCHOLARSHIPS (If available)

Remember there are limited number of scholarships, so be sure to apply early.
