## Financial Aid Opportunities

**International Student Scholar Award** - undergraduate scholarship ranging from \$1,000 to \$6,000 per year, awarded on a competitive basis.

**Out-of-State Scholar Award** - Ranges from \$1,000 to \$3,000 based on SAT or ACT exam results.

**Presidential Scholarship** - For high achieving students, with a history of academic excellence and potential leadership. This award is \$8,000 per year.

**On campus employment** is available for international students, and average wage is \$8.00 to \$8.50 per hour.

## Application Steps:

Take the first step to joining the University of Northern Iowa family. To apply to UNI, you will need to do the following:

- Go to [uni.edu/intladm](http://uni.edu/intladm) and fill out the application for admission.
- Pay \$50 (undergraduate) or \$75 (graduate) application fee.
- Submit educational transcripts.
- All applicants who are not native speakers of English must submit proof of English proficiency.
  - TOEFL–79 Internet based
  - IELTS–6.0 for undergraduate and 6.5 graduate students
  - SAT–480 (new SAT EBRW)
  - Conditional admission may be considered for students with low English results.
- Some graduate programs require other test scores and supporting documents. Check your specific program online at [intladm.uni.edu/graduate/majors](http://intladm.uni.edu/graduate/majors).

## Opportunities at UNI and Beyond

- Within six months of graduation, 95% of UNI students are employed, in graduate school or otherwise occupied.
- The Princeton Review named UNI’s College of Business Administration a “Best Business School.” Graduates are employed by prestigious companies such as John Deere and Ernst and Young.
- Internship opportunities for students exceed the number of students who apply.
- Undergraduate science research is readily available and often leads to opportunities to be named a co-author of a paper or a co-inventor on patents.
- Graduates of the science programs have a high success rate in gaining admission to professional and graduate school.
- Students in the technology/engineering-related programs benefit from strong industrial linkages including partnerships with multi-national companies such as Rockwell Collins and Pioneer Seed.
