**[Taylor's University ADP undergraduate transfer applicants:](#)**

- Taylor's University ADP students with 60+ transfer credits wishing to transfer to NAU may be admitted with a minimum 2.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale (4.0 = A)
- **English Proficiency:** Taylor's students who transfer **ENGL 101 or ENGL 102** with a grade of 'C' or better also receive transfer credit for **NAU's ENGL 101 or ENGL 102**, which satisfies NAU's English Proficiency Requirement.
- Students who transfer both **ENGL 101 and ENGL 102** with grades of 'C' or better receive transfer credit for **NAU's ENGL 105**, which also meets the English proficiency requirement
- Official transcripts must be submitted in their original language and officially translated into English. Please have your school counselor directly email NAU International Admissions your official transcripts from their Taylor's University institutional email to: [studynau@nau.edu](mailto:studynau@nau.edu)

### Taylor's University general undergraduate transfer applicants:

- Students must submit:
  - High school transcripts and diploma, and
  - College/university transcripts for all post-secondary coursework
- Taylor's University students (non-ADP) may be admitted to NAU with a minimum cumulative GPA equivalent of 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale (4.0 = A)
- **English Proficiency:** Taylor's University students who transfer both **ENGL 101 or ENGL 102** with a grade of 'C' or better also receive transfer credit for **NAU's ENGL 101 or ENGL 102**, which satisfies NAU's English Proficiency Requirement.
- Students who transfer both **ENGL 101 and ENGL 102** with grades of 'C' or better receive transfer credit for **NAU's ENGL 105**, which also meets the English proficiency requirement
- Official transcripts must be submitted in their original language and officially translated into English.
