

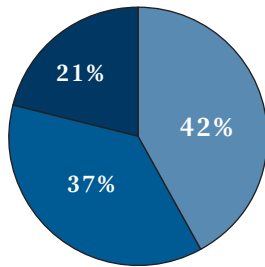


Malaysia & IUPUI

Of IUPUI's approximately 2,000 international students, Malaysia sends the **fifth-highest** number. Since 1991, **754** Malaysian students have attended IUPUI, including **57** enrolled in fall 2017.

History in the Making

On May 2, 2017, IUPUI Chancellor Nasser H. Paydar formalized a new partnership agreement with Universiti Teknikal Malaysia Melaka. The agreement establishes a framework in which students, faculty, and researchers at UTeM and at Purdue's School of Engineering and Technology will participate in academic exchanges and research. In addition, IUPUI proudly works with Yayasan Tenaga Nasional and MARA to prepare Malaysian students for successful careers in business and industry.

Transfer Scholarships

IUPUI will automatically consider you for these scholarships when you apply to be a full time student in the fall and spring semesters. Students can receive no more than one scholarship.

Nonresident Transfer Scholarship (Up to \$14,000)

\$7,000 per year for up to 2 years. You must have studied at an officially recognized postsecondary university, earned a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale, completed at least 12 or more credit hours of accredited university work, and are not an inter-campus transfer or pursuing a 2nd bachelor's degree.
